INITIAL CONSULTATION POLICY

Dear Prospective Client,

Thank you for your interest in Anthony L. Barney, Ltd. ("Firm"). We look forward to meeting with you concerning the issues related to your legal matters. Unlike many legal firms, we offer a reduced fee of one hundred dollars (\$100) for the initial half-hour estate planning or business consultations to our prospective clients. We offer these consultations to allow our prospective clients an opportunity to become acquainted with us, and to properly present us with their particular legal issue(s) or problem(s). The Initial Consultation Policy is designed to inform you of method and manner in which you will be billed, and is part of our records system to avoid any conflict of interest concerning our legal representation.

Our attorney(s) will review your legal matters after the initial consultation, and then make a determination whether to enter a legal engagement with you. If the Firm chooses to enter a legal engagement with you, a formal engagement agreement will be sent to you for your review and signature. Each client will then be required to submit a retainer in accordance with the engagement agreement.

During the initial consultation, each prospective client will be required to make immediate payment for initial consultation period at the reduced fee rate, and after the first half-hour will be billed at the normal hourly rate of the consulting attorney, which is explained further below.¹ The Prospective Client agrees to provide payment prior to or immediately following any consultation for any additional time exceeding the half-hour consultation period. The Firm accepts personal checks, money orders, cash, Visa or Mastercard credit and debit cards, and Discover Card. Any monies paid for initial and/or additional consultation time or for initial and/or subsequent review of documents will not constitute a legal engagement with the Firm unless or until an engagement agreement is signed by you and the Firm. Thank for your professional courtesy in this matter.

¹ The Firm reserves the right to bill the client for the initial consultation and any time exceeding the initial consultation period that is not paid for by the prospective client prior to or immediately after the consultation, without regard to the Firm's acceptance or declination to legally represent the prospective client. You agree to make payment and will be expected to pay the Firm all fees and expenses, as billed, within fifteen (15) days of the date of the billing statement. The Firm retains the right to assess an interest charge of one and one half percent (1.5%) per calendar month on all invoices that are unpaid within thirty (30) days of the date of the invoice. In addition, you agree to pay a late fee equal to five percent (5%) of any amount that is more than 90 days overdue. Interest and late fees shall be added to the amount due and will bear interest and will incur additional late charges until paid. If you default in your obligations to us, you agree to reimburse us for any and all collection costs incurred, including attorneys' fees and costs.
